

## Basic Weekday Morning minyan service, Agudas Achim

Page	What	Who does what, etc.
10	daily blessings	Reader at line 6+. Individually at bottom ¶ to next page at square.
12	top ¶	Reader comes in at square. 2 <sup>nd</sup> paragraph individually or skipped.
13	Master of all worlds	Some readers read English ; some individually; some skip to bottom ¶.
12	last Hebrew ¶	Reader & all, through 3 <sup>rd</sup> line p 14.
14	top	Some skip; others individually; then reader comes in at square.
17-20	* texts & Kaddish	(If a minyan, Rabbi may ask us to read one of the rabbinic texts, then all Kaddish De-Rabbanan)
50-52	Psalms 30	Bottom of page 50 to top of page 52. Individually, then reader at square.
52	* Kaddish	Mourner's kaddish for those in mourning or who have a yahrzeit.
54	Baruch She'amar	Top, together.
80-82	Ashrei	Responsively
82-89	Psalms	Reader chooses which psalm to lead responsively; if page 88, all together.
92	Az Yashir	Generally, only Rabbi leads this until Pesach.
94	Yishtabach	Individually. Reader comes in at square.
94	* Kaddish	Hatzi Kaddish if there's a minyan.
96	* Barchu	Top - 1 <sup>st</sup> line, Reader; then all for next 3 lines.
96	blessings before Shema	Start at line 3 if no minyan. Individually to box at bottom. Reader comes in at square in last ¶.
98	More blessings before Shema	Top: individually to square, then reader may repeat or come in at the square. Kadosh*3 - all together; Reader at square; Baruch K'vod ... all together. Next ¶ individually to square, then reader.
98	Ahavat Olam	Middle: individually to square, then reader may repeat some or come in at the square.
100	Shema	Shema through end of V'ahavta together; last ¶ individually.
102	VaYomer	2 <sup>nd</sup> ¶ together. Last 2 ¶¶, individually to square, then reader comes in at each square.
104	¶ before and Mi Chamocha	Top: individually to square, then reader at square. Mi Chamocha – 1 <sup>st</sup> 3 lines together; individually at square, is repeated by reader. Next 4 lines together.
106	* Amida	1 <sup>st</sup> page, together if a minyan. If not, individually to page 120; skip Kedusha.
108	* Kedushah	1 <sup>st</sup> ¶ individually; is repeated by reader. Next 6 ¶¶ responsively, (starting with congregation doing Kadosh *3) together. Some readers repeat rather than just responsively.
110-120		Individually. Reader may chant a version of Oseh shalom.
(134)	Tachanun	(no Tachanun during Nisan; other months, begins together at 3 <sup>rd</sup> ¶.)
136	* Kaddish	Reader chants Hatzi Kaddish
152-154	Ashrei	Responsively.
159	Responsive reading.	Some readers begin, some ask congregation to begin.
158-160	* Kaddish	Kaddish Shalem.
160	Aleinu	1 <sup>st</sup> 4+ lines together; individually to box on page 162. Some readers come in at last 4 words on page 160; together at box on page 162.
22-33	Psalms of the day	Individually to box, then reader at box.
52	* Kaddish	Mourner's kaddish for those in mourning or who have a yahrzeit.

### \* If there is a minyan

Hallel (begins on p. 380) is added during all of Pesach & Rosh Chodesh. Service will vary during holy days.
