CURRICULUM OVERVIEW

We're proud to partner with the Goldring/Woldenberg Institute of Southern Jewish Life (ISJL) to ensure our children an excellent Jewish education. The ISJL is a regional, transdenominational Jewish organization serving a thirteen-state southern territory. Our school is one of 70 religious schools across this region sharing in the ISJL's Curriculum, coming together each summer for the ISJL Education Conference, and getting visits from our ISJL Education Fellow.

PRE-K - 2ND GRADE CAARS

NEW 7TH GRADE CAARS GESHER

Introducing CAARS Gesher, our new Shabbat-based, Saturday morning, model for our 7th grade B'nei Mitzvah cohort. Learners on the Gesher journey are immersed in: a sense of sacred time, being an integral member of the Jewish people, being loved and cherished by one's clergy and educators, answering the call to participate with "Hineini – Here I Am," and of having a place of leadership within the Jewish community, well beyond b'nei mitzvah.

Students will:

- 1. Experience Shabbat through tefillah, learning, singing, and eating,
- 2. Explore their own personal relationships to Judaism and themselves by engaging in text study, and
- 3. Expand ritual life skills and acquire the ability to fully participate in prayer and celebration.

We are so proud of our amazing teen community for joining us for our inaugural year of jtx: jewish teen connexion! jtx is a new joint Jewish educational program for teens in 8th – 12th grades created in partnership between Congregation Agudas Achim and Temple Beth Shalom. Our intention for 2021 - 2022 is to resume inperson learning, including weekly lunch for our teens as part of their teen engagement experience.
